## FINAL REPORT

**ATTENDANCE:** Schools Attending included: California State University: Bakersfield, California State University: Channel Islands, California State University: Dominguez Hills, California State University: Northridge, Occidental College, Phoenix College, Loyola Marymount University, Saddleback University, Santa Barbara City College, and University of La Verne.

There were 141 registered Delegates from the above schools, 10 Advisors from the above schools, 9 Secretariat members, and 5 Administrative people for WestMUN (Nick, Sondra, Michael, Juni and Peter) for a total of 165.

The catering this year was fabulous, with the exception of too few cookies. But both Silvergreen’s Catering and Three Amigos BBQ were spot on. Our catering costs were: \$6269.00 for Silvergreens and \$2720.00 for Three Amigos BBQ equaling \$8989.00

### WEBSITE DEVELOPMENT:

#### **EVALUATIONS:**

Evaluations were received by the flock this year and they were all over the map. For one thing, we actually got a great number of them back (69) thanks to the Secretariat making sure they handed them out and in fact received them back. Kudos for that one! Overall we scored a 4 out of 5 on most points mentioned on the survey. 17 people answered that they did not bring a computer out of 69. The site being the lowest in terms of scores and the delegates listed the Wi-Fi problems as the most severe issue. Several people mentioned that they also attended Harvard MUN, but felt we were the better conference.

Here are the general comments made on the surveys: Bad Wi-Fi reception/connection. Committee sessions too long with not enough breaks and would like more un-moderated caucus time. Various comments regarding food...perhaps more vegan/vegetarian, but overall the food got good reviews. Suggestions for the website: MORE pictures and videos of the actual conference, more research links for students to learn, Schedule, Rules and standards of WestMUN need to be publicized prior to conference, MAP of campus on website, clearer rules of procedure, Do's and Don'ts for Delegates would be nice.

Realistic simulations in committee were seen by many...(Chair of HRC got glowing comments) BUT many felt that delegates were not acting in character and this was not handled well by the chairs. Concern over people not participating well and it was felt that Secretariat needs to be trained in this area as well as rules and running the committees. Many students wanted WestMUN to be "more" organized and yet they seemed to like the "laid back" feel too. The schedule had no time for "FUN" in Santa Barbara. Schedule could be better/clearer. We need short breaks throughout the conference and when there were two things happening at the same time (i.e. Lunch and speaker...put one before the other and Dinner and Entertainment...put one before the other and where they are both going to take place.)

**SECRETARIAT:** As you know we voted in our new Secretary General: Jesse Tibbetts and Under Secretary General, MacKenzie Garcia. Applications will be mailed Wednesday, April 11, 2012 to: Nick Stewart, Jesse, MacKenzie, Peter and Sondra will maintain the originals in case anyone loses their copies (as we have experienced in the past) Nick, Jesse and

MacKenzie will handle the selection process of our future secretariat and we will be working on a full on retreat for the Secretariat Team in the summer or early fall. We have received applications from nineteen delegates to serve as Secretariat in 2013...A very good turn out. Thank you!

Nick and Sondra have talked and Sondra is looking into getting gavels for each of the chairs and of course our past Secretary General, Gloria.
